Doesn't Randolph already have a neighborhood association?

The Randolph Neighborhood did, at one time, have an active neighborhood association. However, as you well know, "life happens," folks got busy and the previous Association's leadership was unable to continue their term and no one was able to take over. Thus, the Randolph Neighborhood Association slowly became stagnate.

What is a neighborhood association? What does an NA do?

A neighborhood association is a **voluntary** organization of residents who work together to improve and maintain the quality of life in its neighborhood. Associations form out of concern over a particular issue or as a *means of enhancing a sense of community*.

Neighborhood associations can work collaboratively with their local government agencies to facilitate the need for rapid response from local agencies and residents to resolve community concerns.

What if I don't live in Randolph, but near and want to be involved?

Great, we'd love to have you! The city designates neighborhood boundaries; however, neighborhood associations are allowed to determine the area in which they operate. The previous Randolph Neighborhood Association operated in an area including areas inside and outside of the designated city boundaries for the Randolph Neighborhood.

What does it mean to be a good neighbor?

A good neighbor is someone who is interested in their entire neighborhood, shows respect for the property of others and whose interest doesn't stop at the property line. Neighbors are individuals who work together to improve their neighborhood.
